

## White Wine

### **Reserve Saint Marc Sauvignon Blanc (France)**

**£3.10/£4.50/£6.25/£18**

Crushed leaf and ripe citrus fruits on the nose give way to a clean and intensely refreshing fruit flavour on the palate.

### **Prime Cuts White (south Africa)**

**£3.10/£4.50/£6.25/£18**

Be immediately attracted to the jasmine, lemon flowers and bright citrusy overtones on the nose. The palate is packed with tangy fruits and blossom notes - a moreish wine!

### **Pinot Grigio Sanviglio White (Italy)**

**£3.10/£4.50/£6.25/£18**

Pale and fresh but with a juicy citrus character and a hint of nuttiness.

### **Altitudes Chardonnay (Chile)**

**£3.40/£4.95/£6.80/£19.50**

A beautifully rich Chardonnay with tropical fruit flavours and delicate buttery overtones.

### **False Bay Chenin Blanc (south Africa)**

**£3.50/£5/£7/£19.50**

Gentle, ripe apple aromas layered with greengage, lemon and honey. Minerality adds finesse and style to this very drinkable wine.

### **Diez Siglos Verdejo, Rueda (Spain)**

**£22.50**

Complex aromas of fresh grass, nettle and passion fruit on the nose are delicately mirrored on the palate finishing with savoury hints and bitter marmalade notes.

### **Domaine Delsol Picpoul de Pinet (France)**

**£23**

The nose is fruity, slightly floral with green fruits and underlying citrus and lime. A dab of pear drops on the mid weight palate but well balanced with juicy, citrus acidity.

### **Vetiver Rioja Blanco (Spain)**

**£25**

A beautiful wine, with a silky smooth mouth-feel that is packed with white peach, almond and buttery nuances.

### **Lanark Lane Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc (NZL)**

**£26.50**

Intensely aromatic, crisp and fresh, reflecting the world famous Marlborough style.

### **Chablis La Colombe (France)**

**£29.50**

Typical of what a great Chablis should taste like - not a trace of oak, pungent and flinty on the nose with a touch of creamy fruit underneath and a long crisp finish.

## **Red Wine**

### **Reserve Saint Marc Cabernet Sauvignon (France)**

**£3.10/£4.50/£6.25/£18**

A lovely Southern French Cabernet with a classic nose of red berries and rich flavours of blackcurrant and cherry.

### **Prime Cuts Red (South Africa)**

**£3.10/£4.50/£6.25/£18**

In the glass, this wine even looks juicy! The nose is super bright, appealing, a salad of mixed fruits that makes you want to dive into the glass. Masses of strawberry, raspberry, red fruit, with a slightly creamy finish on top.

### **Vina Fuerte Tempranillo Crianza (Spain)**

**£3.10/£4.50/£6.25/£18**

Ruby red colour, with purple and matt tones. Ripe fruit with vanilla spiced hints. Structured in mouth, round, harmonic and wide.

### **Jacana Shiraz (Australia)**

**£3.40/£4.95/£6.80/£19.50**

Dense, bright, magenta hues with aromas of chocolate, spice and juicy strawberries. Flavours of dark sweet fruit abound.

### **Altitudes Merlot (Chile)**

**£3.40/£4.95/£6.80/£19.50**

This wine is full of juicy soft fruit character, typical of a good Merlot, and tantalising hints of mocha and vanilla.

### **Apulo Rosso Salento (Italy)**

**£23**

Intense and fruity bouquet with hints of plum and dried cherry. Dry with a fine structure and outstanding roundness. It shows a complex and persistent fruitiness on the palate.

### **Bodegas Artesa Organic Rioja (Spain)**

**£25.50**

Bodegas Artesa is a large family owned estate that has over 800 hectares of vineyards in the best zones of the Rioja Baja. Classic Rioja, full flavoured with dark fruit and spiced mulberry characters.

### **Cruz Alta Reserve Malbec (Argentina)**

**£26.50**

Serious and luscious wine with excellent depth of aromas, seductive red fruits flavours and length. The palate has balanced acidity inviting with mineral, violet and lovely soft coffee and mocha finish.

### **Vina Edmara Pinot Noir (Chile)**

**£27**

A seductive and complex combination of floral petals and violets, with black cherry and raspberry aromas, mingled with a soft touch of coconut and vanilla on the finish.

**Ch Haut Poitou Lussac St Emillion (France) £30**

A very well-made 2008 with plenty of ripe black cherry fruit, surprisingly so for the vintage. The palate follows the nose with fresh, juicy fruit and body, nicely rounded and robust with a typical dry claret finish.

**Rose Wine**

**Reserve Saint Marc Syrah Rose (France)**

**£3.10/£4.50/£6.25/£18**

The prettiest little salmon pink quaffer in town. Full of red berry flavours and thirst-quenching acidity.

**Mirabello Pinot Grigio Rosato (Italy)**

**£3.40/£4.95/£6.80/£19.50**

A lively rosé with delicate aromas of red berries and a palate of lush summer fruits.

**Los Haroldos Malbec Rosado, Mendoza (Argentina) £25**

With over 40 years' experience, Familia Falasco have come up with a stunning 100% Malbec Rosé. Bursting with juicy strawberries, cherries and raspberries in a youthful, easy drinking style.

**Bubbles**

**Romeo Prosecco Spumante £4.50/£19.95**

Intense and fruity with a rich scent of apple and grapefruit and just the right amount of sweetness.

**Sacchetto, Pinot brut, spumante blush (Italy) £19.50**

Fine and continuous bubbles, this off dry sparkling wine is fruity and appealing with a floral and fresh fruity bouquet and a lingering finish.

**Moutard NV Brut Grand Cuvee (France) £29.95**

Fine and light nose with lemon and acacia fragrance, A full, creamy chardonnay palate leading through to a fresh, clean and fruity finish.

**Moutard NV Prestige NV Rose (France) £29.95**

This has a complex nose- floral, with raspberries and hints of spice. The palate is full and rounded, with a creamy mousse and light acidity.

**Veuve Cliquot NV Brut Yellow Label (France) £54.95**

Powerful and well structured, with an exquisite balance of style and character. A luxury champagne with an exceptional taste.

**Cuvee Dom Perignon Vintage (France) £150.00**

Created only in the finest years, Dom Perignon is the ultimate expression of champagne at its very best.
